PREFACE

The 7th Regional Consultation on Solar Physics was held in Starý Smokovec from Sept. 24 to 28, 1973 under the sponsorship of the Slovak Academy of Sciences (Bratislava) and was organized by the Astronomical Observatory Sklanaté Pleso. The Organizing Committee consisted of L. Pajdušáková (chairman), V. Bumba, M. Kopecký and J. Sýkora (secretary). The general theme of the Consultation was SOLAR ACTIVITY AND SOLAR-TERRESTRIAL RELATIONS.

The Consultation should be regarded as a member of the series that includes the Tatranská Lomnica (Czechoslovakia, 1961), Kalatowki (Poland, 1962), Tatranská Lomnica (Czechoslovakia, 1964), Sopot (Poland, 1966), Potsdam (G.D.R., 1968) and Gyula (Hungary, 1971) meetings.
