In addition to revealing spherical degrees of the excited modes, measured amplitude and pulsation phases yield valuable information about the star which includes constraints on atmospheric parameters and convection. We will present analysis for several modes in FG Vir using data from various sources and various stellar atmosphere models. Practical problems encountered in extracting desired information from measurements will be discussed.
